Human Rights Council Elections 2019: discussions of candidate States' visions for membership

In advance of the Human Rights Council elections that will take place this autumn for the membership term 2020-2022, Amnesty International and the International Service for Human Rights will hold a pledging event for candidate States in Geneva on 11 September 2019.

The event is co-sponsored by the Permanent Missions of Czech Republic, Denmark and Fiji, and is intended to give candidates an opportunity to present their visions for Council membership and to respond to questions from a range of stakeholders on how they propose to realise the pledges and commitments they may have made in seeking election.

State representatives, civil society, National Human Rights Institutions and other key stakeholders are invited to participate actively in the event and pose questions to candidate States.

Candidate States include Armenia, Brazil, Germany, Indonesia, Iraq, Japan, Libya, Marshall Islands, Mauritania, Republic of Moldova, The Netherlands, Poland, Republic of Korea, and Venezuela.
