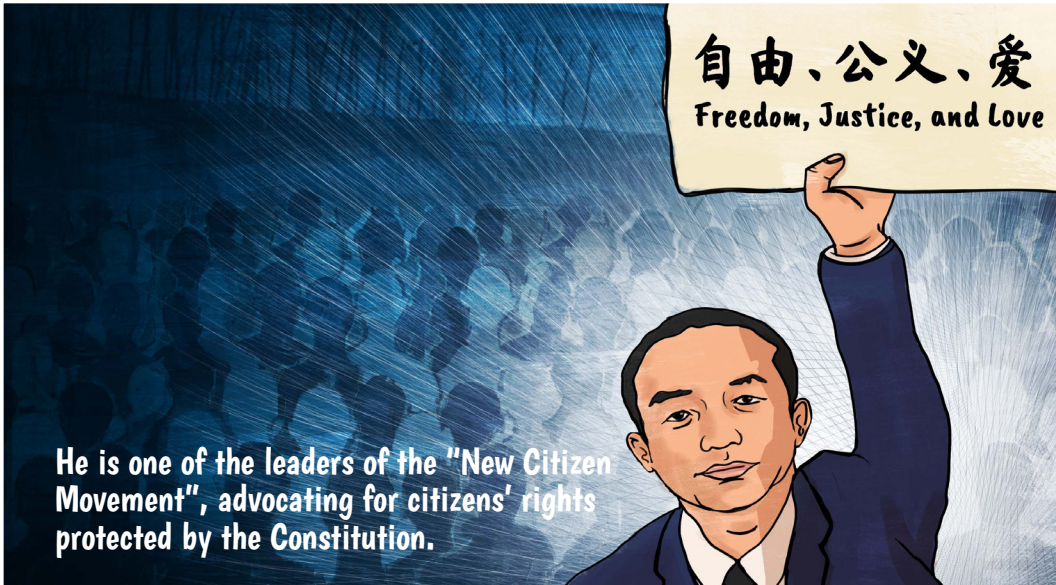




Ding Jiaxi began promoting the rights of migrant workers' children in 2010, also offering legal assistance and food to fellow citizens facing injustices.



He is one of the leaders of the "New Citizen Movement", advocating for citizens' rights protected by the Constitution.

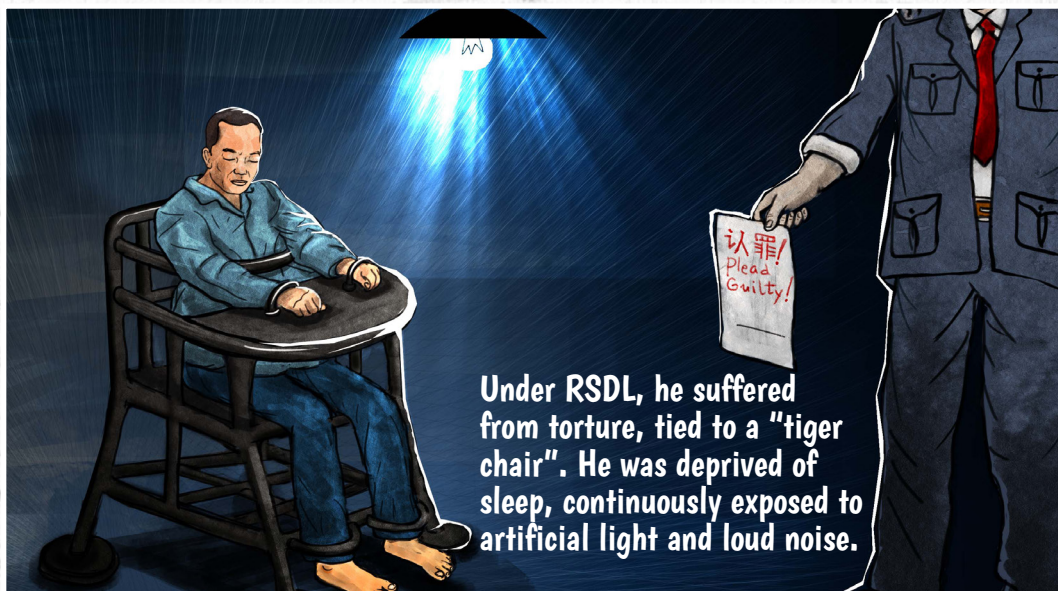


Ding was jailed from 2013 to 2016 for defending the rights of others and asking top officials to disclose their assets.



In December 2019, the police disappeared him, putting him under "Residential Surveillance at a Designated Location" (RSDL).

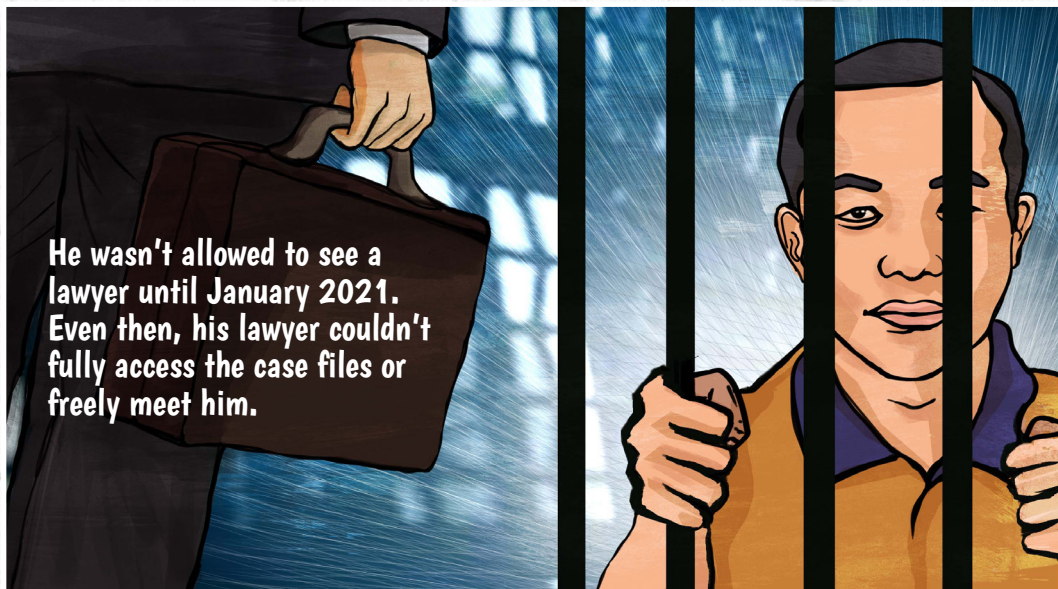
For the next 6 months, no one knew what had happened and where he was.



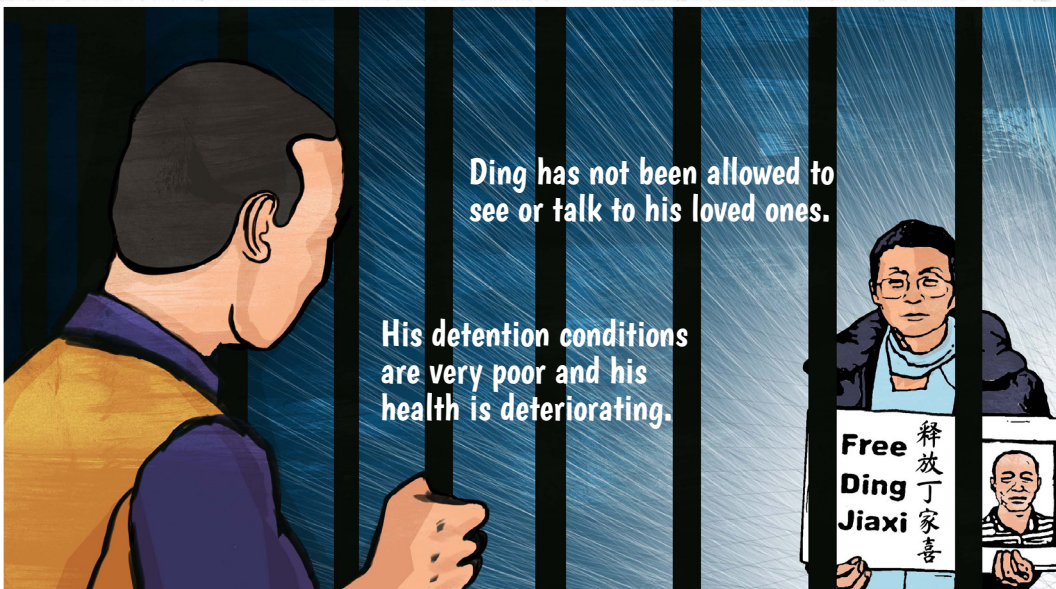
Under RSDL, he suffered from torture, tied to a "tiger chair". He was deprived of sleep, continuously exposed to artificial light and loud noise.



He then reappeared in the city of Linyi, where he was formally arrested, and later accused of "subversion of State power" in January 2021, a very serious crime in China.



He wasn't allowed to see a lawyer until January 2021. Even then, his lawyer couldn't fully access the case files or freely meet him.



Ding has not been allowed to see or talk to his loved ones.

His detention conditions are very poor and his health is deteriorating.
